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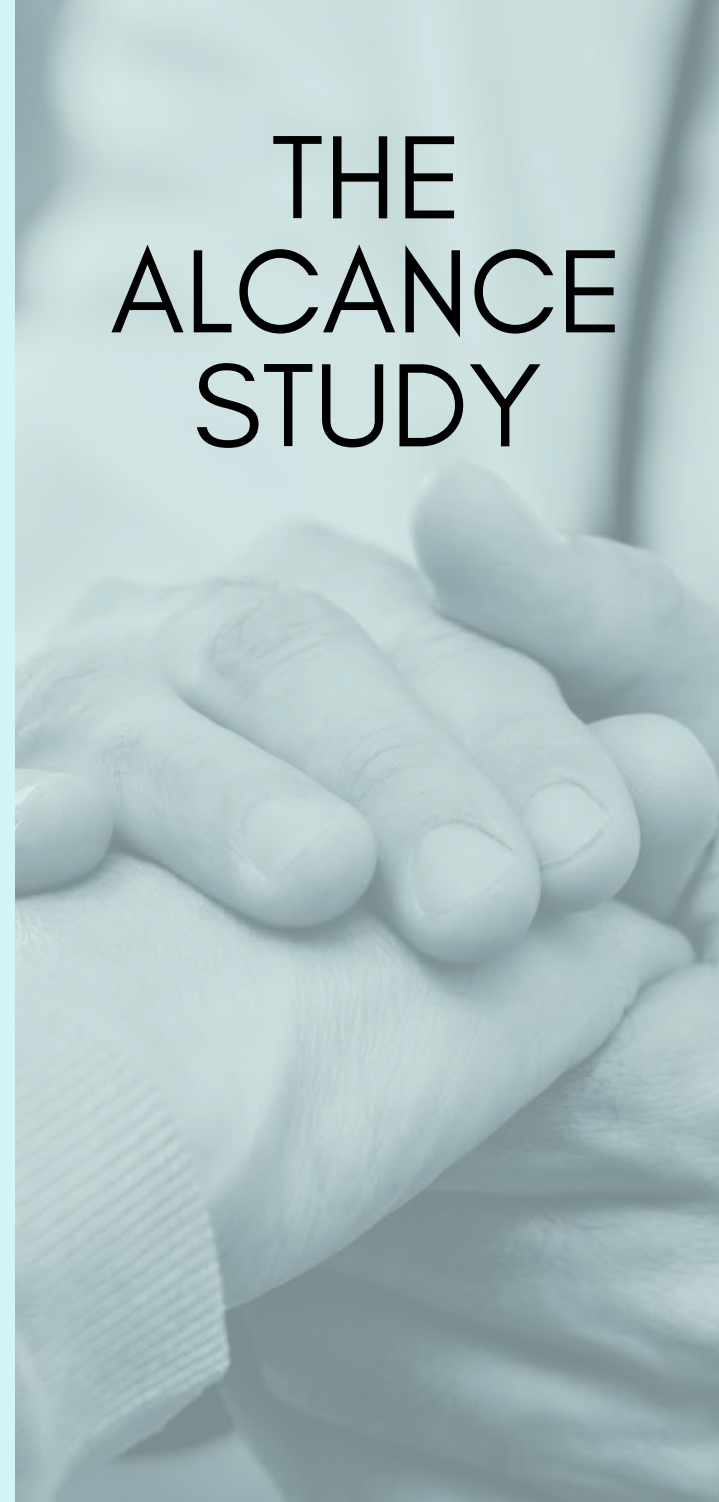
OUR GOAL

The ALCANCE study seeks to improve cancer care for all patients by making sure that you have access to the best treatments, understand your treatment options, and are engaged in your care plan.

STUDY ACTIVITIES

This study is a randomized controlled trial. This means that half of the participants are randomly added to the regular care group and half are added to the regular care + support from a Community Health Worker group.

Those in regular care will continue their care just as before. If you are assigned to the Community Health Worker supplemental support group, you will:

- Learn about Advance Directives
- Set your goals of care
- Learn about precision medicine & tumor testing education
- Receive help tracking your symptoms
- Receive personal support

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE IF YOU:

- Have cancer
- Identify as part of a racial/ethnic minority group
- Are low-income
- Have public insurance, agricultural company insurance, or are uninsured
- Speak Spanish or English

ARE THERE ANY BENEFITS?

By participating, you may gain a better understanding of your cancer and your treatment options. Your participation may also help to pave the way for future Community Health Worker programs.

ARE THERE ANY RISKS?

There are no anticipated medical, financial, or psychological risks in participating.

FAQs

IS IT FREE TO PARTICIPATE?

Yes. There is no cost to join the study.

CAN I CHANGE MY MIND?

Yes. You may end your participation at any time. This will not impact your care at PCC.

WILL I HAVE TO COME IN MORE?

No. We can work with you to schedule study activities during your existing visits or at a time that is convenient for you. Activities can be done over the phone.

HOW MUCH TIME WILL IT TAKE?

Participants will be surveyed at 4 times over the course of 1 year. Each survey takes about 20- 30 minutes. Participants in the Community Health Worker group will also meet with their Community Health Worker regularly in person or by phone to receive support.

ARE THERE MEDICINES OR THERAPIES INVOLVED?

No. This study looks only at your knowledge, engagement, and satisfaction with care.

WILL I BE COMPENSATED?

No. This study does not pay participants.
